- Plan units of inquiry that accommodate a range of needs and ability. (Caring, open-minded and respectful teachers)
- Provoke inquiry through the provision of a stimulating environment and act as guide and facilitator. (Teachers as open-minded mentors)

TEACHING

Teachers will:

- Use a range of teaching strategies-small group, individual, whole class etc. (Teachers as creative mentors)
- Support and promote play and inquiry-based teaching and learning. (Committed teachers)
